**Guidelines to follow before the photo session**

- 1. If you are not using the make-up artist at studio come fully made up with hair done by a professional \_\_\_\_\_**
- 2. If you are using the make-up artist at studio come with a clean face and hair done the way you want it for the first look. Groom facial hairs and pluck eyebrows as needed. Some Make-up artists do hair, but you must make arrangements with them directly \_\_\_\_\_**
- 3. Have you nails manicured \_\_\_\_\_**
- 4. Get a haircut or coloring as needed \_\_\_\_\_**
- 5. Get a relaxing facial or massage \_\_\_\_\_**
- 6. Bring the shade of powder that suits your skin tone and some additional make-up for touch ups \_\_\_\_\_**
- 7. Arrive early to freshen up \_\_\_\_\_**
- 8. Get a good nights rest before the session \_\_\_\_\_**
- 9. For portrait sessions you agree to arrive with the planned clothing color scheme \_\_\_\_\_**

**Clothing will be discussed before a shoot. Nevertheless, the shoot will be most successful if all involved are dressed in a similar color scheme (i.e. all black; white or pastel colors on top darker bottoms, textured clothing is also desirable (i.e. knits) and long sleeves if you don't have Popeye arms. The idea is to wear clothing that doesn't detract from face**
